DIRECTOR'S CUT

The Virginia Museum of Fine Arts is accepting nominations for *Director's Cut*, a free program for students in grades 6–12 with a passion for digital filmmaking. A series of required Creative Film Workshops, led by artist and filmmaker Todd Ravotta, offers students guidance and assistance in using a variety of alternative methods to create one-of-a-kind works of experimental film. The workshops culminate with *Teen Talent: Color + Light*, a visually intriguing exhibition of performance and film, featuring digital works of art created by *Director's Cut* participants.

Nomination Rules

Students may be nominated by a teacher, counselor, principal, or parent/guardian to represent their school. *Students must provide a written statement describing their interest and experience in filmmaking.* Students will be notified through e-mail of their acceptance into the *Director's Cut* program.
