

Architecture, and discuss the development
of their signature structure, the skyscraper.

Excursion: Chicago's Architectural
Treasures. Relax as you admire the city's architectural gems on a guided panoramic tour.
See the neoclassical Wrigley Building and
Tribune Tower; art deco masterpieces including the Civic Opera House and the Merchandise
Mart; and Chicago School standouts such as the Reliance, the Rookery and the Carson Pirie Scott buildings. Snap perfect pictures of the city's skyline from the lakefront museum campus, then take in the Gothic revival John D.
Rockefeller Memorial Chapel and the University of Chicago's quaint quad in Hyde Park.

Local Flavor: Take a break for a tasty lunch at an Oak Park restaurant.

Excursion: *The Wright Way.* Explore the painstakingly restored home and studio of Frank Lloyd Wright with an expert guide. The trailblazing architect and his team finetuned their Prairie School style in Oak Park, just outside the city. Unity Temple, Wright's earliest





commissioned work, is considered one of the most innovative buildings of the 20th century. Tour this recently restored Unitarian church made of cast concrete before strolling along Forest Avenue to admire the largest grouping of Prairie School homes anywhere.

DAY THREE

CHICAGO

Educational Focus and Excursion:

Art Institute of Chicago. This preeminent institution, known for its collection of impressionist paintings and modern artworks, houses centuries of artistic creation. During an engaging talk, learn how its mix of celebrated masterpieces creates a transcendent art experience. Then view the impressive galleries

of this must-see museum with a docent. **Local Flavor:** Enjoy lunch near the

Art Institute.

Excursion: *Chicago Symphony Center.* Explore the home of the world-renowned

Chicago Symphony Orchestra on a behindthe-scenes tour of Symphony Center and Orchestra Hall, the Georgian revival auditorium designed by Chicago School architect Daniel Burnham.

Excursion: *Millennium Park.* See how enchanting art enlivens Chicago's beloved public spaces as you visit the city's premier park. Gaze at Chicago's reshaped reflection in the mirror-like surface of Anish Kapoor's sculpture, "Cloud Gate," known locally as "The Bean." Stroll past Jaume Plensa's Crown Fountain and Frank Gehry's striking contributions: the pavilion with its ribbons of steel encircling the stage and the undulating pedestrian bridge that links the park to the lakefront.

DAY FOUR

CHICAGO

Excursion: *The Driehaus Museum.* Be transported to the beauty of Chicago's Gilded Age as you tour this museum, once the private mansion of a 19th-century Chicago banker. In addition to original furnishings, the grand rooms contain an impressive collection of decorative and fine art pieces, including works by Louis Comfort Tiffany.

Local Flavor: Nosh on lunch at a famous Chicago deli.





Excursion: Chicago River Architecture

Cruise. Marvel at the city's skyscrapers from a different vantage point onboard a cruise along the Chicago River. Discover fascinating details about the city's famous landmarks and the latest additions gracing the skyline.

DAY FIVE D

CHICAGO

Independent Exploration: Today, pursue your own passions in Chicago. 
